5. A Community Hall of the size shown will cost about \$3 million. It will have to be funded through:

- (a) Existing Band funds;
- (b) INAC funding (limited to \$200,000);
- (c) Grants from private and public sources; and
- (d) A mortgage

A possible breakdown of the funding is as follows:

(a) Existing Band funds:	\$ 600,000
(b) INAC funding:	\$ 200,000
(c) Grants from private and public sources:	\$ 400,000
(d) Mortgage	<u>\$1,800,000</u>
	\$3,000,000

A mortgage of \$1,800,000 at a 5% interest would cost the Band approximately \$115,000 per year over 30 years. This is in addition to operating costs (utilities, janitorial, supervision). This type of expense would require the Band to re-allocate funds in some areas and seek new funding sources from government and industry.
