Program Description

The University Preparation program at TRU offers a variety of Adult Basic Education (ABE) courses and programs designed for students who have diverse educational backgrounds and academic goals, including completing course prerequisites for admission into career, vocational and academic programs, or the BC Adult Graduation Diploma (equivalent to the High School Dogwood Diploma).

Courses are delivered in small, student-centered classes through teaching methods that can accommodate students' life experience and learning styles.

Intake Dates

Ongoing, fall (September), winter (January) and summer (May)

Admission Requirements

• Completion of entry assessment may be required.

Course Prerequisites

Students should be aware there are specific course prerequisites. It is strongly recommended students become familiar with these prerequisites, which are available in the TRU Calendar at tru.ca/calendar.

Assessment

If grades are missing from your high school transcript you may be required to complete an Accuplacer Assessment (\$39.90) to better determine academic grade levels. Information about the Accuplacer can be found at tru.ca/assessment/accuplacer/uprep.

How to Apply

Please Note: Most students who require upgrading will apply to the Bachelor of Arts program, not the UPREP program. Please meet with an Academic Advisor to plan your upgrading courses

- 1. Apply online at tru.ca/williamslake/registration or submit your application via email to wlmain@tru.ca or use the paper application form at tru.ca/campus/admissions/apply
- 2. Pay the \$31.02 application fee Please call or visit the campus to pay your application fee. Your application is not processed until this fee is received
- 3. Submit official high school transcripts

Re-application

If you were not accepted, or applied but did not attend last year, you must submit a NEW application and contact the Admissions Office to ensure all required documentation is still on file and complete.

Next Steps

- 1. You will be contacted within 2 3 weeks to confirm we have received your application
- 2. Use the checklist in this package to make sure you have included all supporting documents required
- 3. Once Admissions has reviewed your application and applicable supporting documents, they will notify you about the admission decision
