**Contract Position:** Chief Negotiator

**Contract Summary:**

The Chief Negotiator is responsible for leading the Treaty negotiations on behalf of the Northern Secwēpemc te Qelmūcw (NStQ) to reach a Final Agreement. Negotiations will lead to the completion of land, resources and Self-Government Agreements between NStQ and the Provincial and Federal Governments, while remaining consistent with NStQ's mandates, policies, and vision. The Chief Negotiator will also ensure the protection of NStQ's Aboriginal rights and title.

**Summary of Knowledge and Abilities we are looking for:**

Knowledge of Aboriginal Rights and Title (ART) court cases and precedent law in regard to ART and Consultation and Accommodation. General knowledge of the Northern Secwēpemc te Qelmūcw values.

**Education:** Bachelor's Degree in Political Science, First Nations Studies, Aboriginal Law or a related discipline, or an equivalent combination of education and experience
